Mr Chng Tze Wei was appointed the Assistant Director of the Digital Forensics Branch (DFB) of the Corrupt Practices Investigation Bureau (CPIB) in 2018. He oversees the operations of the DFB, which includes developing new forensic capabilities and enhancing existing forensic capabilities in areas such as computer, mobile and cloud forensics. Chng began his career in CPIB in 2004. Over the years, he was conducted investigative works and digital forensic examinations. In the course of his digital forensic work, he has also appeared as an expert witness in Court for numerous corruption cases involving digital evidence.

Chng obtained a degree in Bachelor of Science from the Murdoch University Australia in 2010, with Double Major in Cyber Forensics, Information Security & Management and Business Information Systems. He also possesses three professional forensic certifications – GIAC Certified Forensic Analyst (GCFA), GIAC Certified Forensic Examiner (GCFE) and GIAC Advanced Smartphone Forensics (GASF). His innate curiosity for technology has him also constantly studying newer technologies and developing novel cybercrime-related forensic capabilities, such as cryptocurrency blockchain forensics.

Chng has received two National Day awards, being the Public Administration Medal (Bronze) in 2021 and the Efficiency Medal in 2014.
